

### **Maths: White Rose and Mastering Number**

Year 1 consolidates place value to 10, addition and subtraction within 10, and recognising 2D and 3D shapes through practical activities. Year 2 extends learning to place value to 100, two-digit addition and subtraction, and exploring shape properties. Both years strengthen fluency and problem-solving.

### **Geography: Maestro-Coastline**

This project teaches children about the physical and human features of coastal regions across the United Kingdom, including a class visit and detailed exploration of the coastal town of Seaton in Devon.

### **English: Literacy**

This term we will be sharing 'Rubbish' by Emily Gravett and 'The Daylight Marriage' by Mia Wittmann. Phonics will be taught through the 'Phonics Inc' scheme. Graduated spelling lists will be practicing their compound words using the VIPERS. Reading books will be shared and sent home every Friday to be read 5 times.

### **RE: Purim and Humanism**

Purim commemorates the strength of the Jewish people. They wear costumes and visit the synagogue to listen to the story of Queen Esther. Families and friends eat, dance and exchange gifts. We will learn that Humanists believe people can make good choices and work together to make the world a happier place.

### **Art/DT: Flower He**

This project teaches children about the structure of flowers, including shape, size, and color. They also explore different materials including drawing, printmaking, paper and clay. Beach Hut will be used for learning about making and strengthening different ways of...
