Maths: White Rose and Mastering Number

Year 1 focuses on place value within 10, addition and subtraction within 10, and 2D and 3D shapes. Year 2 builds on this with place value to 100, addition and subtraction using 2-digit numbers, and properties of shape. Both years develop problem-solving and fluency.

RE: Diwali

The children shall learn about Diwali as a joyful Hindu and Sikh festival of lights. They explore the story of Rama and Sita, discover how families celebrate with diva lamps, rangoli patterns, and special meals, and recognise the festival's message of good overcoming evil.

Science: Human Survival


The children will learn that human survival needs air, water, food and shelter. They explore how humans are suited to their environment, the importance of keeping healthy through diet and hygiene, and how our senses help us to stay safe.

Music: Charanga

The children will explore pulse, rhythm, and pitch. They learn through singing, playing instruments, and listening, building foundational skills in performance and composition while beginning to use basic musical vocabulary.

History: Movers and Shakers

This term, we will be historians. exploring people who have changed our world! We will learn about famous figures from the past and present, discovering how their amazing ideas, bravery and creativity have helped to shape our lives.

School Values: Kindness, Courage and Respect

PSHE: Jigsaw

The children will learn about themselves and their feelings. They explore belonging, friendships, classroom rules, and how to be a good citizen, building self-awareness and understanding their role in the school community.

PE: Get Set For PE

Year 1 and 2 children will develop fundamental movement skills like agility, balance, and coordination. They will also engage in teambuilding activities, learning to cooperate, share space, and work together in fun, inclusive games and challenges.

English: Drawing Club and **Phonics**

While sharing a variety of quality texts, traditional tales and animations, Drawing Club blends storytelling, drawing and play to develop vocabulary, creativity and confidence in their writing. Phonics will be taught through the Read, Write Inc scheme. Reading books will be sent home every Friday.

Art/DT: Mix It!

This project teaches children about basic colour theory by studying the colour wheel and colour mixing. It includes an exploration of primary and secondary colours and how artists use colour in their artwork

Computing

The children learn essential online safety, including protecting personal information. They develop basic skills in using technology, such as giving instructions to devices and understanding how to use the internet responsibly and safely with adult guidance.
