

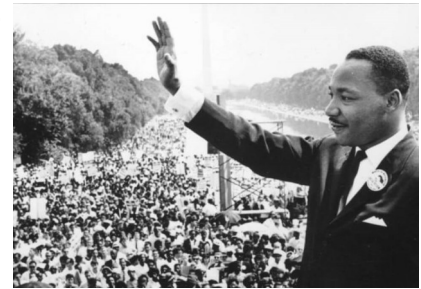


Norton sub Hamdon Primary Weekly Update
