Maths: White Rose, Times Tables and Fluent in Five.

Years 3 and 4 will focus on place value, addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, and continue to learn times their tables up to 12, developing fluency and problem-solving skills.

Years 5 and 6 will develop their skills in place value, addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, fractions, decimals, percentages, and times tables to enhance fluency and reasoning.

History: Through the Ages
