

R.E. - Islam: Lailat al Miraj - Children learn about Muhammad's Night Journey, the importance of prayer in Islam, and how Muslims celebrate this special event.

R.E. - Humanism: How can I know what is good? Children learn about humanist ethics, focusing on making good choices, considering consequences, empathy, wellbeing, and improving life without religious rules.



Y3 & Y4 Science: Plant Nutrition and Reproduction – Children learn what plants need to grow and survive. They identify parts of flowering plants and understand how roots, stems, leaves, and flowers each have important jobs.

Y3 & Y4 Science: States of Matter – Children learn about solids, liquids and gases, their properties, and how materials change state when heated or cooled.

Y5 & Y6 Science: Human Reproduction - Children learn about animal and human life cycles, including growth, puberty, reproduction, and changes from birth to old age.



Art: Islamic Patterns - Children learn about features of Islamic art, creating geometric patterns on paper, fabric and clay, then design and make a high-relief clay tile decorated with patterns.

DT: Tomb Builders - Children learn about simple machines, including pulleys, levers and ramps, and how ancient builders moved and lifted heavy loads.



PSHE: 'Relationships and Changing Me' (Taught in same-sex where more appropriate)

Y3 and Y4 – Children learn about families, friendships, safety online, global citizenship, body changes, stereotypes, and preparing for transitions to new stages.

Y5 and Y6 - Children learn about self-esteem, online safety, healthy relationships, puberty, body image, and preparing for change and growing responsibility.

Y3 and Y4 Maths: Children will learn to measure length and height using decimals, solve addition and subtraction within 100, and work with money and time. **Y5 and Y6 Maths:** Children will study ratio, algebra, decimals, money, shape, and revise key SATs skills to consolidate learning.

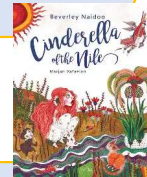
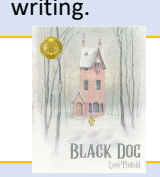
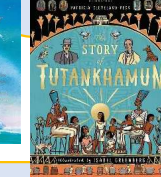
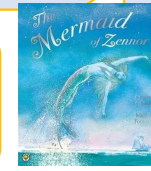
Y4 will work towards their multiplication check. Y6 – SATS. Oak Class will ALL continue with daily arithmetic and times tables.

Class Read:

Books: Black Dog, Cinderella of the Nile, The Story of Tutankhamun and The Mermaid of Zennor.

Writing Outcomes: Children will enjoy exploring four rich texts while developing grammar and punctuation skills, learning new vocabulary, and creating both fiction and non-fiction writing.

History: Ancient Egyptians - Children will learn how ancient Egypt began and how it united into one kingdom. They will compare it with Neolithic Britain, explore Egyptian gods and beliefs about the afterlife, discover how pyramids were built, and learn about Egypt's greatest pharaoh.

Computing: Data Logging – Pupils learn why data is collected, how sensors monitor environments, and how to collect, access, and analyse data using computers.

Selection in Programming Pupils learn to create programs using questions and selection, design and implement a quiz, then evaluate their work against set criteria.

Continue with **Online Safety** learning.



Music: Children will continue with weekly singing assembly alongside learning songs for the Moving Up Celebration (Y6) and Leaver's Service. They will continue to learn to play the glockenspiel – focusing on playing a tune and in harmony. Mrs. Jones will teach music to Oak Class.
