#### What a busy week for Acorns!

We have had a fantastic week of learning both indoors and out! Acorn class have been learning about Neil Armstrong and why he is a significant person in history. We have been learning about our bodies and what humans need to survive including a healthy balanced diet and good hygiene. Our story in Drawing Club last week was 'The Little Red Hen'. We helped the Little Red Hen use her bread to make jam sandwiches and then wrote the instructions during our English lesson. We then performed the story during our Harvest service. In art we have been learning about colour and the artist Kandinsky. We have also been tidying the forest school area and filling our planters with fresh compost.

#### Some serious investigations in Oak Class...

Oak Class have had a fantastic week of learning! In Science, we made our own 'blood samples' to explore the components of blood and investigated how exercise affects our bodies. In History, we examined Stone Age weapons and used primary and secondary sources to learn all about life in Skara Brae. Our English lessons produced some brilliant 'How to Survive in the Wilderness' guides — truly fantastic reads! Year 6 completed their first SATs practice with great focus, while Years 4—6 impressed with their rounding work. We've also enjoyed super swimming, hockey, and netball sessions in PE!
